On December 15th, 2020, Mr. Chip Smith was admitted to Beaconshire Nursing Center from the hospital which left him bed bound and paralyzed from the waist down. Maximum assistance was needed for functional mobility.

Prior to be admitted to Beaconshire Nursing, Mr. Smith had a goal to be able to either walk again or move freely in a wheelchair, and just with a little bit of assistance and determination his goal was obtainable.

When Mr. Smith made significant improvement with his ambulation, becoming independent with his wheelchair, decreased neck pain and increased strength and endurance enabled him to achieve increased independence.

We are so excited to see Mr. Smith moving around the facility and enjoying his everyday life.

Mr. Smith would like to thank physical therapy and those who cared enough about him to help him with his rehab. "I wouldn't be where I'm at today if it weren't for the Beaconshire Nursing staff."
